# COMING TO A GOLF COURSE NEAR YOU!

Kyllinga: pronounced kill-ling-a. A fitting pronunciation, considering what our golf course is in the process of doing right now. Kyllinga is a warm season sedge type plant that has slowly been creeping up to Maryland and Pennsylvania in recent years from down south and has taken up residence predominately in our fairways. Blame it on global warming if you like. Regardless, it's a perennial grass looking weed that will completely take over large areas of turfgrass if left unchecked.

We have begun the process of eradicating the plant from some of our fairways and tee boxes at North East and will continue the process this Fall and again in the Spring. The good news is that it is controllable with select herbicides. The bad news is that you see what appears to be dead turf for a couple weeks until the new grass seedlings emerge that we're planting. After the first frost, like crabgrass, the kyllinga will turn brown and become dormant. But unlike an annual like crabgrass, it doesn't have to rely on seed to spread and left unchecked, it will return next Summer.

Since it is a warm season plant species, you won't see it next Spring. And with the maintenance program we have in place for next year and beyond, you won't notice it again.

# PLAYER OF THE YEAR POINTS

The Player of the Year Point race is winding down. The Top 30 Players to date are listed on the front page. There are still 5 events left on the Tournament Schedule that could earn points to get you into the top 30. These events are: Labor Day Mixer, Ladies Classic; Men's Net Championship; The 2 Person Team Championship (Open to Men and Ladies); and The Paul Gehring Cup.

The Top 30 Players will qualify for The Tournament of Champions, which will be held on Sunday, October 24<sup>th</sup> at the Rising Sun Course. Tee times will start at 1:00pm. This will be a free event offered to the Top 30 players based on points earned for the year. The format for the tournament will be 18 hole stroke play using 80% of the players handicap. Players who qualify for the Tournament of Champions will have their Player of the Year point totals reset for this event. (Please see attached Reset Points chart).

A new set of tournament points will be awarded as well, based on the place the player finishes The Tournament of Champions. (Please see attached Tournament Points chart). The low net round of this tournament will be awarded the Champions Cup and have their names engraved as the 2010 Champion. The highest point total of the players Reset Points and Tournament of Champions Points will be the 2010 Player of the Year for Chesapeake Bay Golf Club and win a 2011 Individual Membership.

We are looking forward to great fall and hope to see everyone playing in these events.
